HIGH ROLLER 2013 PINOT NOIR

Sonoma Coast

VINEYARDS

High Roller Pinot Noir is sourced from the Sonoma Coast Appellation, which encompasses the coolest and most ocean-influenced areas of Sonoma County including Carneros, Petaluma Gap and Russian River. The wine's spice, earth and dark fruit flavors are wonderfully pure and perfectly balanced. The Sonoma Coast appellation may be hard to define, but winemakers love it because it allows us the freedom to express our creativity among some of Northern California's best cool, foggy and expressive micro climates.

VINTAGE

2013 Was a very special year for the Sonoma Coast appellation as the mild growing season and dry summer and fall kept rains away until well after the fruit was all picked. The mild fall weather meant that Sonoma Coast experienced a "classic" vintage.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were hand-picked at night and early morning to retain freshness and acidity. We 100% destemmed at the winery and then after a brief cold soak macerated the wine in tank for about 12 days before pressing off. After being pressed, the lots went through 100% malo-lactic fermentation. Oak aging, with French oak and a touch of American for vanilla and spice notes, contributed body, finesse and well-balanced character.

WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

Our flagship wine is crafted for those who "go big", at the dining table as well as the game table. This robust pinot stands up and demands notice. It's the perfect complement to grilled herb salmon or the celebration in your comped suite after you've made the house feel a little pain.

The wine has classic aromatics of black cherry, strawberry coulis, violets and baking spice. On the palate, complex layers of sweet red and black fruit, and plum jam mingle with spicy oak notes, forest floor and a brisk finish. High Roller Pinot Noir is a flavorful and elegant Pinot that can stand up to steaks and grilled dishes as well as pair with Pinot Noir classics like duck, pork and charcuterie.
